## **JOB CALL: GRAPHIC DESIGNER**

### **Job Overview:**

Full Circle: First Nations Performance is seeking a contract-based Indigenous Graphic Designer who can develop creative material for collaborative projects we will be doing with partnering organizations for this year's Talking Stick Festival and ongoing events. This role reports directly to the Artistic Managing Director and works in close collaboration with the Marketing Lead, producers and other members of the team.

The graphic designer must have the ability to create original concepts, articulate and interpret ideas and vision of the Artistic Managing Director while collaborating with the Full Circle team on the execution of the marketing materials. The successful candidate must be self-motivated, highly organized, very communicative and work with a sense of urgency and timeliness.

**Hours of Work:** part-time contract with higher workload from Mid April to the end of June. For reference, graphic design for a typical festival season will include the creation and production of 8 -12 digital deliverables with room for a number of revisions until finalized. Workload will be heavier in May and lighter through June.

### **Responsibilities:**

- Digital marketing asset creation - produces email signatures, social media banners and content, program guide, video title cards.
- Website asset creation - visual website enhancement
- Out of home advertising
- Print Advertising
- Television and video frames
- Works closely and collaborates with the Full Circle team to ensure all designs align with programming and branding.

- Must have experience using inDesign, Photoshop, Illustrator or comparable creative software.
- Must have the ability to communicate clearly with good organizational and planning skills.
